# CAULIFLOWER CLUB 1<sup>ST</sup> XV TO PLAY IN BOWRAL SATURDAY 27<sup>TH</sup> MARCH

A compelling display of brawn over brains is on the cards as the latest iteration of the inglorious Cauliflower Club XV (CCXV) lay down the gauntlet to the allegedly formidable Wilted Tulips Bowral Blacks Rugby XV this Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> March in Bowral NSW.

World Cup-winning Wallabies coach, Bob Dwyer, will attempt to mould the CCXV’s raw and unbridled talent, with sideline supervision from former Wallabies Greats such as Al Baxter and Sterling Mortlock.

Preceding the gladiatorial display, the former Wallabies will conduct a Rugby Skills & Drills session on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March from 4:30pm at Eridge Park, Bowral (next to the Bowral Blacks home ground). Joining the former Wallabies is a motley collection of paddock warriors and broken-down Rugby Heroes with more guts than greatness, made up of former Country Rugby Legends (in their own minds) such as Swag, Rug, Keg & Temple – with a minimal backline represented by ‘pretty’ Old Boys and haircare enthusiasts Maggot, Hoss and Barks.

The Cauliflower Club was established in 2012 by former Wallaby greats, Peter FitzSimons and Nick Farr-Jones to raise funds to provide sporting and recreational equipment to enhance the lives of those with a disability, with a bias towards sporting-related injuries.

For those less familiar with the great game of rugby, the Charity is so named for its sincere adoration for the unsung heroes of the forward pack with their mangled cauliflower-resembling ears on the frontline of the rugby battlefield - rather than their quicker, twinkle-toed brethren in the backline...
